✿ Status: increasing or stable

✿ Population: 4,000-4,500

✿ Wintering: 2,000


✿ Migrating: 2,000-2,500

✿ Wintering/migrating sites: Cheorwon, Paju,
Han river estuary, Junam reservoir, Yeoncheon


✿ Threat: habitat reduction

1978-79 year(Won, 1981)




Hooded Cranes *Grus monacha*

- ✿ Status: stable(?)
- ✿ Population: ca. 5,000
 - ✿ Wintering: 350–650
 - ✿ Migrating: 4,000–5,000
- ✿ Wintering site: Suncheon bay
- ✿ Migrating sites: Cheonsu bay, Gumi, Han river estuary
- ✿ Threat: habitat reduction






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
Hooded Cranes migration

Black-faced Spoonbills


Platalea minor

- ✿ Status: increasing
- ✿ Population: ca. 1,200
 - ✿ breeding- 500-600 pairs
 - ✿ wintering- less than 30 birds
- ✿ Breeding Sites : up to 15 islands on the western coast of Korea
- ✿ Wintering : Jeju island
- ✿ Threat: reclamation







Total 15 Breeding sites in Korea, 2003-2012
