



- ✓ Heilongjiang and Jilin Provinces, 130 000 KM2
- ✓ 7 municipal cities, 33 counties, 40 Forestry Bureaus
- ✓ Core habitat 39000 KM2, 万平方公里, 6 municipal cities, 13 counties, 8 Forestry Bureaus




- ✓ 9 individuals in 1990' s
- ✓ 42 individuals (Camera Trapping)

- ✓ Habitat in 20000 KM2

全国东北虎种群及栖息地分布图




全国东北豹适宜栖息地及历史分布图



Policies of Conservation

- ✓ 1950' s, Ban to stop killing tiger;
- ✓ 1962, Protect tiger in the list;
- ✓ 1977, put tiger into Rare Animal List
- ✓ 1980, Sign the CITES, tiger in the appendix I;
- ✓ 1988, Wildlife Protection Law, tiger listed in first grade National Protect Animals.
- ✓ 1993, State Council Banned the use of tiger bone
- ✓ 1998, State Forestry Administration make out “National Action Plan for Wild Tiger Conservation” ;
- ✓ 2000, Tiger was list as most important species of the National Wildlife Protection Program;
- ✓ 2011, State Forestry Administration make out the Plan for Wildlife Tiger Recovery.
- ✓ 2013, China and Russia start to make the Transboundry Work plan for Amur tiger and Leopard.






