


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


NOWPAP History

- Established in 1994 by *the People's Republic of China, Japan, the Republic of Korea and the Russian Federation* as an integral part of **UNEP Regional** *Seas Programme (RSP)*.
- The RSP has been promoted since 1974. Nowadays, the RSP covers in total 18 regions across the world, with about 140 participating countries.



UNEP Regional Seas Programmes






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Goal of NOWPAP

Geographic coverage 33-52°N, 121-143°E





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NOWPAP structure









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

Goal develop *effective regional cooperative measures* in response to marine pollution incidents, including *oil and HNS spills*











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


Impact of global warming on coastal and marine ecosystems in the Northwest Pacific (2011-2013) - funded by **APN**

Goals:

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• *Analyze spatial and temporal variability* in oceanographic conditions and recruitments of major fish species in the NOWPAP sea area for the last 40 years

• *Forecast changes in potential production of fisheries resources and evaluate risks and vulnerabilities*, induced by climate change, in fisheries - dependent sectors across NOWPAP countries

UNEP- led *Global Outlook Report* on the State of Marine Biodiversity, launched at CBD COP-10 (2010)




