## AN OPEN, PARTNERSHIP ORGANISATION

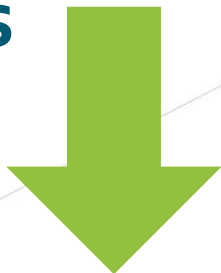
- over 200 Accredited Entities and delivery partners

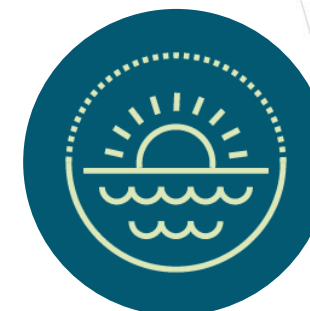
