WHAT ARE THE CHALLENGES?

- Building long-term relationship between cities
 - Difficult to maintain the communication between cities after the programme
 - Cities consider this programme as one-time event
 - Therefore we offer fund for cities to implement sustainable pilot projects for cities
 - Pilot projects will let cities to have continuous dialogues and this can be beneficial for both parties
- Virtual Meetings and Online Gatherings under COVID-19
 - Building communications through online meetings is very difficult
 - Online meeting can be difficult to generate meaningful results




