





Background

Designed to promote and champion the people-centered digital transformation of the public sector that is geared towards providing more accessible services for all citizens.

What is it?

Identifying the exemplary models of city governments as well as individual, corporate, and institutional efforts in ensuring an inclusive digitalization of public services that benefit all people in sectors ranging from mobility, safety, welfare, environment, culture, and governance.

Category?

- Innovacity: Projects that focus on integration of innovative policies and technologies in all sectors of society and domains ranging from sustainable environment, culture, and governance.
- **Human-Centricity:** Projects that are designed to prioritize digital inclusion in smart city development, thereby overcoming or mitigating the digital divide, and that aim to serve specific target groups among the citizen population, such as the elderly, youth, and the disabled.
