# A. <u>Policy Cooperation: Policy Analysis Report and Policy Dialogue</u>

### Approach and modality

- **Policy Analysis Report**: Share the best policy practices and support policy exchange and collaboration among member States.
- **Policy Dialogue**: Engage policymakers and stakeholders from member States to facilitate productive discussions and actions in shaping the NEACAP 2026-2030 Work Plan.

# **Key Activities**

- *A.1: Publication of the Policy Analysis Report (January 2025):* Upon approval of the final draft by SOM-27, the secretariat will hire a copy editor, contract a vendor for layout design, and release the e-copy for distribution (Budget: USD 8,000).
- *A.2: Organization of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Policy Dialogue* (Q2, pending SOM-27 decision): Following SPC-6 recommendations, this event will focus on identifying priorities for the NEACAP 2026-2030 Work Plan (Budget: USD 22,500).

# B. Capacity Building

## Approach and modality

• Targeting institutions or officials to enhance their skills in effectively assessing or addressing air quality challenges.

#### **Key Activities**

• *Customized Training Programmes*: Based on proposals from countries or SPC members or technical centers, tailored training programmes will be developed and implemented, including budget estimations (Budget: USD 11,250)

## C. Knowledge and Information Sharing

#### Approach and modality

• Facilitate the exchange of experiences and the sharing of knowledge on recent research, policy updates, and advancements in air quality management technologies.

# Key activity

• *Symposium:* An outreach activity to promote the key messages from the Policy Analysis Report (Second half) (Budget: USD 11,250).

• *SPC-7 Meeting* (*Q2*): A face-to-face meeting in tentatively in May, with online intersessional meetings to draft NEACAP 2026-2030 Work Plan (Budget: USD 11,250).
